Galilee

.And the eleven disciples marched into Galilee to a mountain where Jesus had appointed or instituted them (Greek εταξατο) This mountain was not one of which we have any other command-though there may well have been confirmation in the following hours. It was (in my view) the mountain where the principles of the kingdom were first enunciated and so it takes on deeper significance now at the end of the ministry of Christ.

Worship and doubt

The disciples beheld Jesus quite clearly as they went up the mountain. The first sight lead to worship but some were in two minds (Greek $\delta i\sigma \tau \alpha \zeta \omega$)

Jesus came close-personal experience

Matthew tells us that the LORD approached close enough to show Himself to families and individuals within the group. Now they had the evidence at close range. At the end of the Galilee experience there were no doubters.
